HONOR FLIGHT

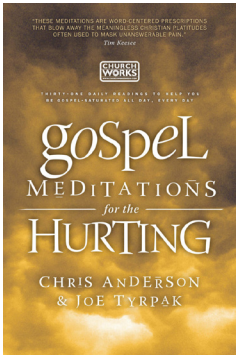
